

Code of the Fayre and Indemnity Insurance

You are expected to attend your sections Safety Briefing Meeting as arranged by your Section Leader.

Your help and co-operation will be greatly appreciated.

- I declare that during the whole period of the Berwick St. John Country Fayre, my entry will be covered by Public Liability Insurance, which includes rally use, and where necessary by a Boiler Explosion Policy, having a limit of indemnity of not less the £2,000,000 (Two Million Pounds).
- I further declare that in case of any event taking place wholly or partly on the Public Highway, that the vehicles hereby entered are covered by insurance as required by the Road Traffic Act 1960, which is valid for such part of this event which will take place on such roads defined in that Act.
- I further declare that the Boiler of any steam engine carries a current Board of Trade Inspection Certificate and that I will produce documentary evidence of such insurance for your inspection before participating in the Berwick St. John Country Fayre.
- I confirm that the driver/drivers of any vehicles owned by me holds and is not disqualified from holding a Licence to drive a vehicle of the appropriate class.
- Understand and follow ALL safety rules.
- Please ensure that you follow Stewards and Section Leaders requests.
- **No vehicle movement on site between the hours of 10am - 5pm.**
- No person may drive an exhibit on site unless they have a current driving licence and the vehicle is insured for public liability.
- No alcoholic drink to be consumed whilst driving or operating machinery.
- Please put all litter in the receptacles provided.
- Elsan tips are provided, so please use them.
- If you see something you think is not right or is unsafe and dangerous, report it to the Safety Officer, Section Leader or Admin. immediately.
- **ONLY ONE PERSON TO BE PERMITTED TO RIDE ON A TRACTOR (must be over 16).**

Arrival at the Showground The showground is situated 5 miles from Shaftesbury, 12 miles from Salisbury, just off the A30 in Berwick St John. Exhibitors will be allowed to access the showground from 7am on Friday 16th September. The Holding Area will be open from 6pm on Thursday 15th September. Once you have checked in at the Exhibitors entrance, you will be directed to your Section. Please report to your Section Leader who will show you where to set up and camp.

Exhibitors Holding Area will be open from 6pm on Thursday 15th September. Access to the showground will be from 7am-10pm on Friday 16th and again from 7am Saturday morning. If there is a query with your entry form / pass you may be asked to wait in the Holding Area until your Section Leader/Secretary has checked your paperwork.

Lorry Parking Many exhibits arrive directly from The Dorset Steam Fair, this only possible by prior arrangement on an individual basis by contacting Richard Pocock at Manor Farm on 01747 828272. All low loaders and lorries should use the lorry park allocated at the entrance to Manor Farm itself.
